STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Southwest Chapter of the Structural Engineers Association of Washington (SEAW - SW) is offering two \$1,000 scholarships to college students studying Structural Engineering and who plan to make his or her professional career in the practice of Structural Engineering.

Requirements of Students applying for the SEAW-SW Scholarship:

1. United States citizen and an official resident of the State of Washington within the geographical area covered by the Southwest Washington Chapter of SEAW (Tacoma / Olympia and the surrounding geographical area), and enrolled at a four year college or university. The location of the college or university need not fall within the boundaries of the Southwest Washington Chapter of SEAW.
2. A sophomore or higher ranking undergraduate; or a graduate student at the time of application.
3. Enrolled in a program of study majoring in Structural Engineering.
4. Having a commitment to making a professional career in the practice of Structural Engineering

How to Apply:

1. Complete the attached application form and return to the SEAW-SW office at the address above. E-mailed applications are acceptable.
2. Arrange for the school to send directly to SEAW-SW at the above address a transcript showing courses taken and grades received from them.
3. Arrange for completion and return to SEAW-SW of two scholarship recommendation forms by two professors. They should be provided stamped envelopes addressed to SEAW-SW at the above address.
4. Completion of the scholarship recommendation by an employer is optional but will be beneficial, as employment experience will be considered by the selection committee. Arrange for employer to return the form directly to SEAW-SW as in item 3 above.
5. Complete a personal Essay on "Why Structural Engineering is the Applicant's Career Choice" and attach it to the application. The Essay should be limited to 500 words.
6. All documents must be in the committee's hands by March 31 to be considered for the scholarship to be awarded April 20.

How the Scholarship Winner will be selected:

From qualified students submitting applications, the SEAW-SW selection committee will determine those to be interviewed (if necessary). They will be notified and interviews will be scheduled after April 5th in Tacoma or Olympia. Only those interviewed will be given further consideration. At the selection committee's discretion, the interview component of the selection process may be eliminated. Final decisions relating to all matters of eligibility and award of the scholarship rests solely with the SEAW selection committee.

The scholarship winners will be announced by April 20th.
